

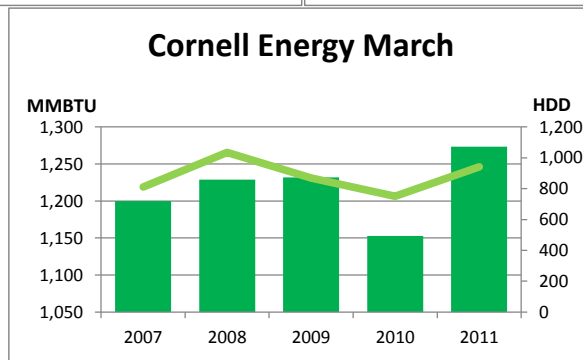
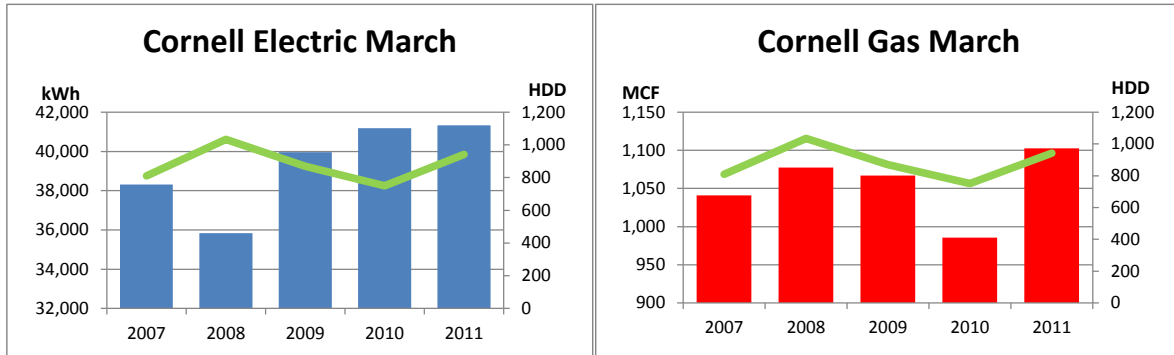
Monthly Energy Report

Cornell

March, 2011



This month, Cornell used 41,330 kWh of electricity and 1,102 MCF of gas, for a total of 1,273 MMBTU of energy use. This is a 10% increase in total energy use from this month last year and a 6% increase from the three-year average. Electricity costs for this month were \$3,265 and gas costs were \$7,055 for a total cost of \$10,320.



In the last 12 months, Cornell has used 459,658 kWh of electricity and 7,639 MCF of gas, for a total of 9,414 MMBTU of energy use. This is a 10% increase in total energy use from the previous 12 months. Electricity costs for this year were \$36,313 and gas costs were \$48,892 for a total cost of \$85,205.
