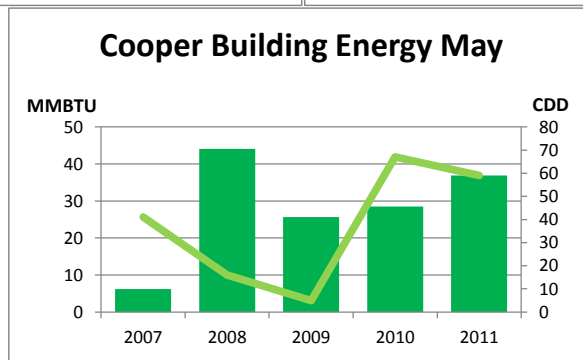
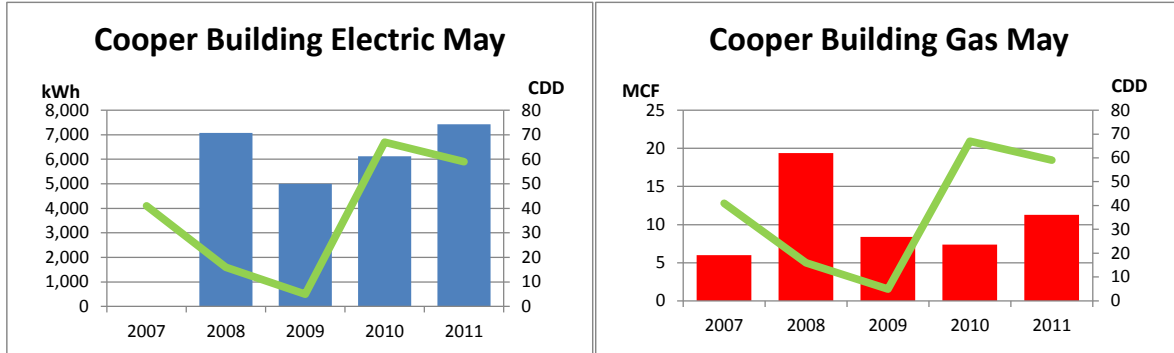


Monthly Energy Report

Cooper Building

May, 2011

This month, Cooper Building used 7,420 kWh of electricity and 11 MCF of gas, for a total of 37 MMBTU of energy use. This is a 30% increase in total energy use from this month last year and a 13% increase from the three-year average. Electricity costs for this month were \$586 and gas costs were \$72 for a total cost of \$659.



In the last 12 months, Cooper Building has used 90,160 kWh of electricity and 409 MCF of gas, for a total of 728 MMBTU of energy use. This is a 19% increase in total energy use from the previous 12 months.

Electricity costs for this year were \$7,123 and gas costs were \$2,617 for a total cost of \$9,740.
