Purpose

This procedure is intended to outline Physical Plant expectations for digging on campus.

Procedure

- 1. Digging, excavating, and ground penetration on campus in excess of 6" of depth requires a completely filled out Digging/Excavating/ Ground Penetration Permit.
 - 1.1 Individuals digging without a properly completed Digging/Excavating/ Ground Penetration Permit will be required to repair all damages caused by the dig.
- 2. Individuals signing off on the Digging/Excavating/ Ground Penetration Permit are indicating that they have located and marked all objects (utilities, etc.) known to them that are below grade.
 - 1.1 Signature does not imply that there are no other objects below grade.
- 3. Individual performing the excavation must take all precautions possible with the understanding that there may be unidentified and unknown objects below grade.
