OBJECTIVES:

EMU's General Experimental program in psychology offers a Master of Science degree in experimental psychology. Our program is based on a 'mentor model' in which your program of study, progress, training and thesis are supervised by one or more faculty members. The general program does not prepare or qualify the student for a license in the state of Michigan as a clinical psychologist. The program is designed to accommodate students who are preparing to apply to a doctoral program, or those who are working in a basic or applied research area seeking career advancement. Some students aspire to teach in community colleges and high schools.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

The Master of Science degree in general psychology requires the completion of 30 graduate credits, of which at least 24 must be graduate credits in psychology. All students who apply are encouraged to seek out a faculty advisor, or mentor, who will act as their sponsor. If you are uncertain about a mentor choice, or are applying from another campus, you will be assigned a temporary mentor, based on mutual interest, by the coordinator of the general program. The program is highly individualized and the role of your mentor is an important one. Your mentor will supervise your training, your research, and your M.S. thesis. Should your interests change, a new mentor may be selected with approval from both faculty members and the General Experimental program coordinator.

WHAT WE NEED FROM YOU:

1. A "Statement of Purpose." This is a statement of your experience and achievements and your career goals. In order to facilitate the matching of student and mentor, you should clearly state your reasons for applying to our program and the specific area of experimental psychology in which you would like to do your research.
2. Two letters of recommendation
3. Official transcripts from your undergraduate institution(s)
4. GRE scores
5. The supplemental sheet (enclosed)
6. A sample of your writing (optional, but helpful)
