The above options and intent codes will be aggregated under their respective major code. Be sure to make clear the distinctions between the options and intent codes in the reports for these programs.

**IT99 Industrial Technology** is the title code for the graduate programs in the department. While there should be no data available under that code, any data that might be available will be provided separately for your evaluation and analysis.

Additionally, based on a review of ISIS major/submajor codes, the following Industrial Technology program codes were not addressed in your memo and will also undergo Program Review:
