In response to your Program Listing memo dated May 1, 2002, the Department of Sociology will review the following programs during the 2002-2003 Program Review cycle:

Undergraduate

SC01 Sociology
SC31 Sociology – Secondary Teaching Certification.

The request to review the above programs together is approved, due to the similarity in the curricula for the two programs. Make note that any variances between the programs should be clearly pointed out in the report.

SC02 Anthropology
SC03 Criminology and Criminal Justice including:
SC0301 Concentration in Legal Studies
SC0302 Concentration in Law Enforcement
SC0303 Concentration in Corrections
SC0304 Concentration in Management

The above concentrations will be aggregated under SC03. Be sure to make note of the distinctions between the areas of concentration in the report for this program.

Note that Sociology graduate programs will undergo Program Review during the 2003-2004 cycle. After that time, all Sociology programs will go through Program Review in a single year beginning with the 2007-2008 cycle, per my memo dated February 28, 2002.
