Learn to Swim Class Descriptions

The Eastern Michigan University Rec/IM Learn-to-Swim program provides instruction to help swimmers of all ages and abilities develop their swimming and water safety skills. All classes are taught by certified water safety instructors (WSI).

TOT – Parent/child class for six months through three years. One parent/guardian must accompany child in water. Water adjustment skills, games, songs.

PRE-SCHOOL – Parent/child class. One parent/guardian must accompany child in water. Water adjustment skills, preliminary aquatics skills, games, and songs. This class will help children who may be fearful of the water.

LEVEL I – Four and five-year-olds. Water exploration and elementary aquatics skills for children with little experience. Front and back crawl and glides, armstrokes and kicking, breathing techniques with instructor assistance.

LEVEL II - Primary skills for locomotion. Bobbing, rhythmic breathing, front and back float & glide with kicking, front and back crawl armstrokes and kick, safety skills.

LEVEL III –Retrieving objects from bottom in chest deep water, jumping into deep water from poolside, front and back glide with push off, front and back crawl for 10yds and turning over.

LEVEL IV – Focus on stroke improvement. Front and back crawl, elementary back stroke, breaststroke, sidestroke, and butterfly. Changing directions and positions in the pool. Treading water and various water entries.

LEVEL V – Focus on stroke refinement. Surface dives, flip turns while on front and back, treading water with various kicks. Swimming laps.

LEVEL VI – Refining strokes so students swim with ease, efficiency, power, and smoothness over greater distances.

ADULT CLASSES – Grades10-Adult. Beginner/Intermediate.

Refund/Credit policy — You may have a change of plans or mind about participating in the Learn-to-Swim Program. If so, we appreciate hearing from you as soon as possible so that someone on the wait list may be contacted. There is no refund, credit or reduction of fees for classes missed by a student. We are not able to make cash refunds. If you would prefer a credit to be used on another class in the future, a full credit will be issued with no processing fee deducted. Refunds will be paid in full when classes are canceled by our department. If a class or activity is canceled due to weather, mechanical failure or other unexpected problems, an effort will be made to schedule a make-up class.
