Regent Mike Hawks called the Athletic Affairs Committee meeting to order at 8:33am.

Motion made to accept the December 6, 2012 minutes. Motion carried.

Melody Reifel Werner introduced a new feature to the Athletic Affairs Meeting; a head coach from each sport will be invited to offer insight , brag about their particular sport.

Baseball:

As Head Coach for Baseball, Coach Jay Alexander has sent six players to the minor leagues, beat University of Michigan six times and Michigan State University three times. He is the 2nd in school history with most wins. He believes in education first. The teams average gpa rate is 3.3. He believes in not only being a great teammate, but a great citizen. His team has completed 1500 community service hours, through Big Brothers and reading to children to name a few. Both him and Nikki Borges, Athletics Development Director, have fundraised \$100,000 for the Locker Room project, \$200,000 for the brick program and new scoreboard, and for his second Assistants salary.

EMU Sport and MAC Update:

The Women's teams are currently 5th in the Jacoby cup and the Men's teams 4th in the Reese cup. Recently, five Athletic Directors have left MAC schools'; however, Administrator positions are all intact.

Fundraising Update:

Nikki Borges, Director for Athletics Development said in terms of fundraising we are \$86,000 ahead of last year. The Development office is in the process of creating 4 ½ minute flash drives of each team. This is an opportunity for alumni and fans to get connected with their favorite team. The Development office is also looking to work with both Marketing and Media Relations Departments for fundraising efforts in the future. Fundraising is a process and EMU is young in our fundraising efforts; we are comfortable right now, though we need to start taking baby steps to make it to the next level.

Good News for Athletics:

James Streeter will be receiving the College Sports Information Directors of America Lifetime Achievement Award on June 13, 2013. The Men's Indoor Track & Field won the MAC Championship while the Women's Team placed second. John Goodridge was named MAC coach of the year. Men's Swimming won their 31st MAC Championship and Buck Smith was named MAC Diving Coach of the year.

- EMU turned in a record-breaking defensive performance, defeating the Northern Illinois Huskies, 42-25, Saturday afternoon, Jan. 26, in the Convocation Center. For the Eagles, the game stood as the first time since Dec. 7, 2004 that the team held an opponent to less than 30 points. That feat occurred against Rochester College, 89-29. The 25 points given up were also the lowest points EMU has allowed since Jan. 21, 1943, when Eastern defeated Hillsdale College, 61-21. It was a dubious day for the Huskies (4-14; 2-4 MAC), who registered just one field goal and a pair of free throws in the opening half for a total of four points. That four-point output broke their own record-low of five first-half points from Dec. 1, 2012. It also tied the 2008 Savannah State Tigers for the fewest points scored in any half during the modern era. The one NIU basket also tied the NCAA record with Savannah State for fewest field goals made in one half. NIU shot 1-of-31 in the first half for a 3.2 percent conversion rate. That mark broke the record previously held by Savannah State, who went 1-of-23 en route to their four-point second half, Jan. 7, 2008. The Huskies started 1-of-2, but went on to miss their next 36 shots over 24:33 of play before making a basket with 14:27 remaining in the game.

Individual Honors

Rachel Iaquaniello

- Rachel Iaquaniello rewrote the record books as the Eastern Michigan University volleyball team won in straight sets, 3-0, over Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, Sept. 7, in the Eagles opening match of the Mean Green Invitational. Iaquaniello, came into the tournament 12 kills behind Roxanne Munch's all-time kill record of 1,537. With the Eagle's leading 24-23 in the third set, Iaquaniello finished off the Islanders with her 13th kill of the match giving her 1,538 for her career, one ahead of Munch's 23-year old record which was set in 1989. That wasn't the only record Iaquaniello broke on the afternoon, as Iaquaniello's 37 attacks against the Islanders gave her 4,466 career attacks, moving her ahead of previous record holder Jennifer Nighswander, who had 4,456 from 2000-2003.

EMU Athletics

- The Fall 2012 cumulative GPA for all student-athletes was the department's highest ever at 3.201. The 2012 Fall semester GPA was a 3.140, the second-best tally in history trailing only a 3.147 GPA set in the Fall 2011 semester.

Gymnastics

- Placed 10th in the nation with a combined team GPA of 3.5239
- EMU was ranked No. 25 in the NCAA National Rankings released by GymInfo. This is the first time the Eagles have been ranked in the top-25 since the 1997 season.

Women's Swimming

- EMU won its seventh straight dual-meet of the 2012-13 campaign at Buffalo. With its win EMU completed its first ever undefeated dual-meet season in Eastern's history.

- Received Division I All-Academic status by the United States Track & Field and Cross Country Coaches Association, the organization announced, Feb. 25.
