Silver Member Status	11 additional hours in Community Service = 15 total hours
Gold Member Status	16 additional hours in Community Service = 20 total hours

***It should be noted that the EMU Accounting Club has the option of awarding one member or candidate with the honor of the Outstanding Member Award.**

Fundraising Credits

Fundraising activities are completed to help with the funding of Beta Alpha Psi and the Accounting Club events. Each semester, one fundraising activity is chosen for the whole group to participate in. This activity will allow for all members to accomplish their entire fundraising requirement; it is not necessary for members to create individual fundraising activities.

Tickets are sold by all members and candidates, and can be sold to faculty, friends and family! Firms sponsor some of the charges to hold the event, and will typically send more than one person from their firm to attend. Refreshments are served so this is a great way to sneak in some networking and get face-time with recruiters and firm representatives.
