Beta Alpha Psi Membership Requirements:

- 1. Must be a declared Accounting, Accounting Information Systems, Computer Information Systems or Finance major.**
- 2. Must have completed nine (9) credit hours of accounting courses which must include ACC 340.**
- 3. Must have a cumulative EMU GPA of:**
 - **3.0 in all subjects completed, OR**
 - **3.25 in most recent 60 semester hours, OR**
 - **3.5 in most recent 30 semester hours.**
- 4. Must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 in all accounting courses completed (does not include Law 293, ACC 240, or ACC 241)**
- 5. Must accumulate the following organization credits each semester:**
 - **1 committee credit → received by actively participating on one of the organizations committees.**
 - **Fundraising credits → fundraising credits are received by selling the minimum amount of each semesters chosen fundraising product, OR by participating in one hour of a particular fundraising activity.**
 - **9 community service credits → each credit may be received by participating in one hour of a particular community service project coordinated, suggested or approved by the officers of the organization.**
 - **11 activity credits → each credit may be received by attending an approved organization event. The 11 events must consist of:**
 - **At least 2 social events held by the organization AND**
 - **At least 8 weekly Wednesday meetings AND**
 - **1 of your choice: Social Event or Wednesday Meeting**
- 6. Must pay the following Beta Alpha Psi dues:**
 - **Local Chapter Dues** **\$30.00**
 - **National Candidate fee (Only Candidate Semester)** **\$55.00**
- 7. As candidates you must also attend:**
 - **Banquet**

Achievement Awards

To achieve awards, members or candidates must complete the following requirements in addition to the standard requirements already listed:

- **Bronze Member Status → 6 additional hours in Community Service
(15 total hours)**
- **Silver Member Status → 11 additional hours in Community Service
(20 total hours)**
- **Gold Member Status: → 16 additional hours in Community Service
(25 total hours)**

Further, it should be noted that Beta Alpha Psi has the option of awarding one outstanding member or candidate with the honor of Superior Member status.

Fundraising Credits

Fundraising activities are completed to help with the funding of Beta Alpha Psi. Each semester one fundraising activity is chosen for the whole group to participate in. This activity will allow for all members to accomplish their entire fundraising requirement; it will not be necessary for candidates or members to create individual fundraising activities. This semester, the fundraising activity will be announced soon. Candidates are required to sell tickets.
