Every semester the Intermedia Gallery Group hosts senior exhibitions in order to provide EMU undergraduate students with the opportunity to display their work as a cohesive body either solo or as a group. Since we are here to support students in the process, there is no application fee and IGG takes no commission on sold artwork. Shows are accepted on a case-by-case basis as decided by IGG staff. Eligibility

Open to all EMU undergraduate students with senior standing and enrolled during the time of exhibition. Exhibitor(s) must be able to gallery guard at least five hours a week during exhibition. Exhibitor(s) must also receive a faculty endorsement (space provided above).

Artwork Submission

Digital images must be submitted with each application on a CD only. Images must be titled with the name of the piece and in JPEG or PDF format. IGG understands that the artwork submitted with the application may differ slightly from that of the actual exhibition.

Due Date

Applications must be turned in to the *IGG mailbox in Ford Hall*.
Fall semester exhibition: due at the end of winter semester
Winter semester exhibition: due at the end of fall semester
 Applications submitted during the semester of exhibition may be considered only if an opening becomes available. Notification of accepted applications will take place before the beginning of the exhibition semester.

Calendar

When scheduling shows, we will consider the number of applications and the preferred date of application listed above when deciding on an exhibition date for each accepted application. Accepted applicants are guaranteed one week but never more than two weeks for an exhibition. IGG staff will

assist exhibitor in preparing before each show. Artist(s) must be available for setup and take down of their exhibition

Statement

Include a written statement telling us about your work and/or the theme of the show. Tell us about the meaning of your work and why you create the work you do. You should include everything you think we should know when evaluating your work. Also include a list of your work, include title, media, and size. No more than one page please.

IGG Provides

- Gallery guards only during our regularly scheduled hours of operations. Additional guards may be provided by the exhibitor for extended hours.
- Graphic design services through AIGA (if needed)
- Basic hanging supplies and tools (i.e. nails, tape, hammer, etc.)
- Limited labor for hanging and deinstalling a show.
- Access to Art Dept. equipment (based on availability: pedestals, projector, etc.)
