Once a year the Intermedia Gallery Group hosts the Annual Juried Student Exhibition. Since we are here to support EMU students in the process, IGG takes no commission on sold artwork. Also, all entry fee money collected will be put directly into awards.

Eligibility

Open to all EMU undergraduate students enrolled during the time of exhibition. Submissions must be artwork that has been created during the student's time at EMU. Artwork rejected from previous exhibitions are eligible for resubmission, however, artwork accepted to a previous Annual Juried Student Show will not be accepted again.

Juror

This year we are pleased to have Gregory Wittkopp, Director of the Cranbrook Art Museum.

Artwork Submission

We accept any and all original works done by the artist in any medium. However, we have limited space and facilities, so please inform us of any large or unique pieces which may require special attention or equipment. We will work out a means for set up and removal for these special accommodations. Unfinished pieces or work-in-progress will not be accepted.

All artwork must be submitted digitally on a CD, no exceptions. Provide only one image of each 2-D submission and no more than two images for 3-D submissions. Label CD with the student's name only. Images must be titled with the name of the piece. Images should be in JPEG or PDF format and no larger than 5 MB each (exceptions made only for digital artwork). For video submissions, please submit on a separate CD or DVD. Accepted motion graphics/video pieces will be looped together on a single DVD. CDs will not be returned.

For **EACH** submission there is a \$5 fee. Cash or check is acceptable, makes checks payable to Intermedia Gallery Group.

Disclaimer

The executive members of IGG, the Art Department, and/or Eastern Michigan University do not take responsibility for any theft or damage done to any pieces as a result of burglary, vandalism, fire, larceny, flooding, or acts of sublime misfortune. However, as the Student Show Coordinator, IGG will take all reasonable measures to prevent these things from happening. If you are interested in insuring a piece, you must contact Larry Newhouse via the EMU Art Dept. for the appropriate documentation and form.

Application Deadline: Nov. 14

Applications must be turned in to the *IGG mailbox in Ford Hall* (Room 114) by Friday, Nov. 14, 2008 at 5 PM. Late applications will not be accepted and will be returned to the artist.

Notification of Accepted Work: Nov. 17

ONLY students whose work has been accepted will be contacted personally by phone on or before Monday, Nov. 17, 2008. All others will be notified via email.

Work Drop-Off: Nov. 24 & 25

All accepted artwork(s) must be dropped off by Nov. 24 or 25, 2008. Pieces dropped off must be "ready to hang" (see below).

Ready to Hang

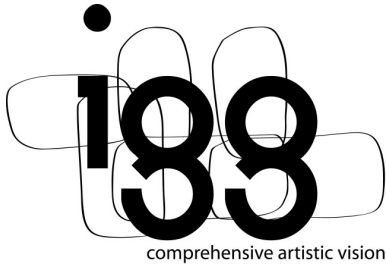
Accepted artwork should be ready to hang. In other words, all 2-D artwork should be dropped off with any necessary hardware already in place. Artwork with such issues as wet paint, unsealed charcoal, etc. will not be accepted. Pedestals and other installation/display materials will be provided for 3-D artwork.

Reception & Awards: Tuesday, Dec. 2

The reception will be held in the University Gallery, Tuesday, December 2, 2008 from 4 PM to 6 PM. Awards will be announced at 5 PM. Please attend if you have accepted work(s).

Artwork must be picked up from the University Gallery on Friday, Dec. 19 from 10 AM – 6 PM
