Eligibility Info and Application Instructions: Both undergraduate and graduate students are eligible to apply for this scholarship, which is awarded based on financial need and grade point average (requires 3.0 GPA for undergraduates and 3.7 GPA for graduates). Preference will be given to applicants with affiliation to Wolverine/Wollack Human Services, but this award will not be restricted to such candidates. Please follow the instructions below in order to apply.

Completed applications should be sealed in an envelope and placed in the red “Scholarship Drop Box” located outside of Marshall 317. All applications are due by 5:00 on April 4, 2011. Scholarship monies will not be made available until summer session—please note that these scholarships are not applicable to the spring 2011 semester.

Directions:

- I. Write and attach a brief personal statement (suggested length 250 to 500 words, no more than 500 words, double spaced, typed, with at least a 10 point font) about your financial need which prompts you to apply for this scholarship.

- II. Attach a copy of your latest Progress Report or EMU transcript (it does **not** have to be an official transcript) with your grades up to and including last semester. Note: This scholarship requires 3.0 GPA for undergraduates and 3.7 GPA for graduates.

- III. Complete and attach the Eligibility Cover Sheet on the next page.
