Eligibility Info and Application Instructions:

The Bonine, Barr, Loppnow, Marshall and Whyte Scholarships are awarded to undergraduate and graduate students based on a combination of criteria which include: personal statement, financial need, and grade point average. Please note that you only need to complete one set of the application procedures below in order to be considered for the Bonine, Barr, Loppnow, Marshall and Whyte scholarships. Completed applications should be sealed in an envelope and placed in the "Scholarship Drop Box" located on the table outside of Marshall 317. All applications are due by 5:00 on April 8, 2009. Scholarship monies will not be made available until summer session—please note that these scholarships are not applicable to the spring 2009 semester.

I. Write and attach a brief personal statement (suggested length 250 to 500 words, no more than 500 words, double spaced, typed, with at least a 10 point font) about your commitment to the social work profession and its mission.

II. Write and attach a brief personal statement (suggested length 250 to 500 words, no more than 500 words, double spaced, typed, with at least a 10 point font) about your financial need which prompts you to apply for this scholarship.

III. Attach copy of your latest Progress Report or EMU transcript (it does not have to be an official transcript) with your grades up to and including last semester.

IV. Complete and attach the Eligibility Cover Sheet on the next page.
