
ADVISING TIPS

Familiarize yourself with the General Education Program!

All students, regardless of their major, must complete the general education program



Make sure you stay in good Academic Standing!



Good Academic Standing: Maintaining a GPA of 2.0 or above, and a course completion rate of 67% (finish and pass 67% of the classes you attempt)

Academic Plan Status: If your GPA falls below a 2.0, you will be placed on an academic plan to allow you time to improve your GPA

Dismissal Status: If you do not meet all conditions of your academic plan, and your GPA is below a 2.0 for two semesters in a row, you will be academically dismissed from EMU

SI works directly with academic departments and faculty to provide support in some of the most challenging general education and/o-r gateway courses.


Peer Academic Coaching
