

Scholarships Offered to Graduate Students

For New Domestic and International Students

- **National Scholars Program (NSP) Scholarship**
 - **Award:** A renewable award that pays the difference between in-state and out-of-state tuition (approximately \$6,240 per year for two years).
 - **Eligibility:** Open to incoming graduate students with a 3.6 or higher GPA on a 4.0 scale from the equivalent of a US bachelor's degree.
 - **To apply:** Consideration is automatic if funds remain at the time your application is processed.
- **EMU Student Success Scholarship**
 - **Award:** \$6,200 total award (\$3,100 per year for a total of two years).
 - **Eligibility:** Open to incoming graduate students with a 3.2 or higher GPA on a 4.0 scale from the equivalent of a US bachelor's degree.
 - **To apply:** Consideration is automatic if funds remain at the time your application is processed.
- **The University Fellowship Program**
 - **Award:** The award is in the form of a scholarship, ranging from \$500 to \$4,000 for the academic year
 - **Eligibility:** New graduate students must present a minimum 3.6 undergraduate GPA and graduate students who have already begun their programs must present a minimum 3.6 GPA to receive consideration.
 - **To apply:** Applicants must complete a *Financial Assistance Application for Graduate Students Form*.
 - **Deadline:** Applicants must submit the form and the requested documentation to the Graduate School by February 15 for the fall semester or October 15 for the winter semester.

- **The Barton Scholarship**
 - **Award:** The maximum award is \$4,000 for the academic year.
 - **Eligibility:** Applicants must either be enrolled in the final semester of their undergraduate program of study at EMU, or have previously earned a baccalaureate degree from EMU. Applicants must have a minimum undergraduate 3.5 GPA.
 - **To apply:** Applicants must complete a *Financial Assistance Application for Graduate Students Form*.
 - **Deadlines:** February 15 for the fall semester or October 15 for the winter semester.

- **Melvin and Hazel Cant Scholarship**

- **Award:** This award is in the form of a scholarship of approximately \$1,900.
- **Eligibility:** A student with a minimum GPA of 2.5.
- **To apply:** Students must complete an application along with an essay about your desire to work in the teaching profession.
- **Deadline:** Application is due in February each year

- **Evans-Strand Scholarship**

- **Award:** This award is in the form of a scholarship of \$1,000.
- **Eligibility:** Student must be in good standing and currently enrolled at the EMU
- **To apply:** Students must complete an application along with an essay about significant contributions you have made to advance the understanding and further the acceptance of diversity at EMU
- **Deadline:** Application is due December 1st each year

- **College of Arts & Sciences Endowed Scholarship**

- **Award:** This award is in the form of a scholarship of approximately \$400.
- **Eligibility:** A fulltime student with a minimum GPA of 3.5.
- **To apply:** Students must complete an application and provide an essay about why they chose their major.
- **Deadline:** Application is due in February each year
