

## Sexual Misconduct

- Sexual assault
- Sexual exploitation
- Nonconsensual sexual contact
- Sexual or gender-based harassment

## Intimate Partner Violence (IPV)

Any act or threatened act of violence between people who are or were in a sexual, dating, spousal, domestic or other intimate relationship.

## Stalking

A course of conduct directed at one person in a way that would cause a reasonable person to fear bodily injury or to experience substantial emotional distress.

## Retaliation

Any adverse action taken against a person for reporting (or participating in a proceeding about) an incident of sexual misconduct or interpersonal violence.
