

Summary of General Education Review Committee meeting of December 5, 2013

This meeting addressed the function of the committee in reviewing the program as a whole and evaluating its goals, learning outcomes, supporting processes, and benchmarking it against peer programs and best practices. The committee is designed to review the program in its entirety, in the sense of overall program review. It will work in concert with the Evaluation Subcommittee (of the General Education Committee) in preparing a report for the university community.

At a minimum, the committee will assess: if the supporting processes are functioning effectively and what process modification, if any, should be considered; faculty suggestions for improvements and enhancements; student satisfaction; employer feedback and how effectively the program supports EMU's partnerships with other higher education institutions.
