EMU's College of Business continues to be accredited by the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB).



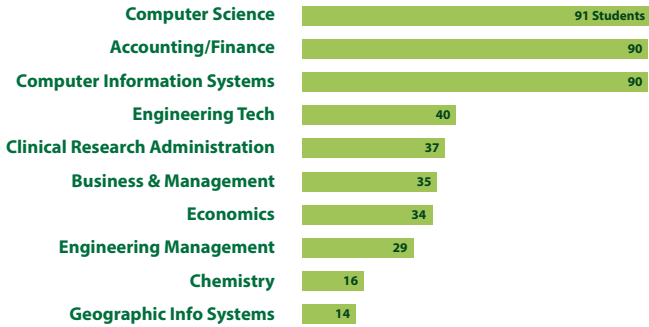
