

The seventeenth century was a period of immense political, economic, social, religious, and cultural transformation. This course explores the ways in which artists and architects responded to these forces, and the ways in which their art helped to inflect the culture of their time.

Visual images will provide a lens for us to investigate larger cultural developments including the Protestant and Catholic Reformations, the Scientific Revolution, the rise of absolutism, and colonial expansion in the New World. We will consider the artist's professional education and practice, the rise of the art market, and developing theories of artistic originality and creation. Through a close engagement with Baroque visual culture, students will develop competencies in visual literacy, critical reading, and written and oral communication.

This class fulfills program requirements in Art History, Studio Art (BFA, BA, MFA), and is an approved elective in Religious Studies

ARTH 100: Art Appreciation (GEKA)

This course provides an introduction to visual culture: from works of fine art in museums to the built environment and the mass media images that saturate our daily lives. You will learn to interpret what you see and understand the vital role(s) that art has played in expressing—and shaping—cultural values, philosophies, beliefs, and identities.

We will highlight historical contexts, cultural influences, formal aspects of various forms of art, as well as critical thinking and appreciation for art and design. Although the foundation of this course is art history, it also includes elements of art criticism, object analysis, aesthetics, and experiential learning.

This Gen-Ed class is designed for learners of any level of knowledge and experience with the arts.


