Digital Fabrication is a beginner course offering students the opportunity to experiment with new tools and materials to build on their discipline-specific art practice. Students in all areas of concentration (2D, 3D, Photography/New Media, Graphic Design, and Animation & Gaming) are eligible to register for this course. The class will introduce students to a variety of techniques using 3D printers, 3D scanners, laser cutters, CNC milling machines, vacuum forming machines, and more.

Join us this summer for **Mud + Wood + Metal**, a 10-day intensive course at the **EMU Parsons Center**, taught by Professors John DeHoog and Brian Nelson. The daily format will include lecture, demonstration, presentations, exploration of the 90-acre property, and time for working. During the 10 days, students will design and realize a significant project utilizing clay, wood, and steel that responds to their experience on the local site. Past projects have included sculptural objects, video, installation, performances, and ephemera. Students live on site for the duration of the class, housing is provided for a nominal fee. The Parsons Center is located a west of Traverse City in Lake Ann, Michigan. Included on site: a dining/meeting hall, bathroom/showers, dormitory, general studio/classroom, ceramics studio, and faculty house. Pre-requisite: AD 122 3D Design or comparable experience.
