

Agreement between
The Schoolcraft Scholars Honors Program at Schoolcraft College and
The Honors College at Eastern Michigan University

The Schoolcraft Scholars Honors Program at Schoolcraft College and the Honors College at Eastern Michigan University (EMU) have collaborated to create a seamless transfer of academic courses from the associate level to the baccalaureate level for Honors students. The goal of this articulation agreement is to admit Schoolcraft Scholars Honors students who have completed the criteria specified below into the EMU Honors College and to outline the circumstances under which Schoolcraft College students may use Honors requirements completed at Schoolcraft toward the requirements for graduation with Honors College Honors from EMU. General guidelines for students and colleges are:

- All graduating Schoolcraft Scholars wishing to apply to the Honors College at EMU must first be admitted to the university through the regular admission process.
- Once admitted to EMU, students who have completed the Schoolcraft Scholars Honors Program in good standing will automatically be qualified for admission to the Honors College at EMU.
- A letter confirming the completion of the Schoolcraft Scholars Honors program will either be transmitted to the Dean of the EMU Honors College from the Program Coordinator of the Schoolcraft Honors Program or uploaded into the Honors College admissions system at EMU. The letter will confirm that student has completed a minimum of six Honors courses at Schoolcraft College and maintained an overall 3.3 GPA on a 4.0 scale. (The Schoolcraft Scholars Honors program requirements include Honors Humanities 190, Honors Sociology 290, four (4) Honors option courses, and 50 hours of service to the community.)
- Students who have completed the Schoolcraft Honors Program in good standing must complete a formal application to the Honors College at EMU, but any requirements for an essay or letter(s) of recommendation will be waived.
- Up to 15 semester credit hours of Schoolcraft Honors courses accepted as transfer credit at EMU may be applied toward the University Honors pathway at EMU and up to 18 semester credit hours of Schoolcraft Honors courses accepted as transfer credit at EMU may be applied to the Highest Honors pathway. Up to 3 semester credit hours of Schoolcraft Honors courses accepted as transfer credit at EMU may be applied toward the Departmental Honors pathway at EMU with the approval of the appropriate EMU Department. Graduation from the Honors Program at EMU will occur when the appropriate program of study and all requirements for a specific Honors pathway are completed.
- Certified service hours accumulated by Schoolcraft Honors students may be applied to up to 50% of any service requirement for an Honors pathway in the Honors College at EMU. The student will be responsible for maintaining a record of all service contact hours completed at Schoolcraft and submitting them to the EMU Honors College.
- Students who have completed the equivalent of an approved EMU Honors experience or experiences at EMU may apply one experience completed at Schoolcraft College to the requirements for University Honors at EMU and may apply two experiences completed at Schoolcraft College to the requirement for graduation

with Highest Honors at EMU. (Graduation with University Honors requires the completion of three Honors experiences, and graduation with Highest Honors requires the completion of five Honors experiences.)

- Upon admission to EMU, the student will complete an Orientation with the Honors College at EMU prior to the first semester of courses.
- By the end of the first semester, the student will attend an EMU Honors College Undergraduate Research Workshop and will meet with an Honors advisor to create an Honors “Plan of Study” for the EMU portion of the Honors curriculum leading to fulfillment of an EMU Honors Pathway (University Honors, Departmental Honors, and/or Highest Honors).
- The Dean of the EMU Honors College will notify the Program Coordinator of the Schoolcraft Honors program when a Schoolcraft Scholars Honors graduate has completed the requirements of the EMU Honors College.

Effective Date: September 1, 2022 until August 31, 2025.

This agreement is consistent with the 2022-2023 catalog. Students have until summer 2030 to graduate from Eastern Michigan University following this agreement. In the event that a student does not complete the program within seven years, they may be required to have their credits reevaluated using the requirements of the current articulation guide.
