

## **Agreement between The Schoolcraft Scholars Honors Program and The Honors College at Eastern Michigan University**

The Honors Program at Schoolcraft College and the Honors College at Eastern Michigan University (EMU) have collaborated to create a seamless transfer of academic courses from the associate level to the baccalaureate level for honors students. The goal of this articulation agreement is to admit Schoolcraft students who have completed the criteria below into the EMU Honors College. General guidelines for students and colleges are:

- All graduating Schoolcraft honor students wishing to apply to the Honors College at EMU must first be admitted to the university through the regular admission process.
- Once admitted to EMU, students who have completed the Schoolcraft Honors Program in good standing will automatically be qualified for admission to the Honors College at EMU.
- A letter confirming the Schoolcraft honors program completion will be transmitted to the Director of the EMU Honors College from the Faculty Director of the Schoolcraft Honors Program. The letter will confirm that the honor student has completed six honors courses at Schoolcraft and maintained an overall 3.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale. (The Schoolcraft honors program requirements include Honors Humanities 190, Honors Sociology 290, four (4) honors contract courses, and 100 hours of service to the community.)
- All Schoolcraft honors courses accepted as transfer credit at EMU will also be accepted as EMU honors courses. Graduation from the Honors Program at EMU will occur when the appropriate program of study is completed.
- Certified service hours accumulated by Schoolcraft honor students will transfer as partial fulfillment of any service requirement of the Honors College at EMU. The student will maintain a record of all service contact hours.
- Upon admission to EMU, the student will complete an Orientation with the Honors College at EMU prior to the first semester of courses. An advisor will work with the student to create an Honors “Plan of Study” for the Honors portion of the EMU Honors curriculum leading to fulfillment of “Full Honors” (University Honors and Departmental Honors) by the end of the first EMU semester.
- Completion of 15 Honors credits at EMU (inclusive of coursework and thesis) approved by the EMU Honors College, and completed at EMU, leading to graduation with Full Honors (University and Departmental Honors).
- Completion of the undergraduate Research and Senior Thesis workshops at EMU within the first year of matriculation at EMU.
