Student Achievement Data Fall 2024

Job Placement: For the 13 undergraduate IDE graduates from the class of 2023-24, 31 % were employed in commercial design, 62 % in residential design, 7 % in other work (freelance) , 0 % headed to graduate school.

Annual program survey/data-collection for graduates showed 93 % employed in their major at the time of this report (**Dec 2024**) with 0 % of those seeking a different type of position with other/more advanced responsibilities.

Acceptance into a Graduate Program: 0 % of the 2023-24 graduating seniors applied to a graduate program.

Graduation Rates – time to degree: For year 2023-2024 undergraduate graduating students:

- 46.4 % were transfer students who finished the program in two years.
- Of those who came as freshmen 30 % they finished in 4 years.
- 16 % completed the degree in five years.
- 0 % completed the degree in six years.
- 0 % completed the degree in seven years.
- 7.6 % of the graduating undergraduate students were second bachelor admittees this year.

Retention/Attrition: From 2022-2023 to 2023-2024, the interior design program retention rate was 87% for undergraduate students (of the 15 IDE students in Fall 2023, 1 transferred + 1 did not pass).
