Student Achievement Data Fall 2022

Job Placement: For the undergraduate graduates from 2021-22, 47% were employed in commercial design, 47% residential design, 5% in other work, 0% headed to graduate school. Annual program survey/data-collection for graduates showed 94% employed in their major at the time of graduation (April 2022) with 0% of those seeking a different type of position with other/more advanced responsibilities.

Acceptance into a Graduate Program: 0% of the 2021-22 graduating seniors applied to a graduate program.

Graduation Rates – time to degree: For year 2021-2022 undergraduate graduating students:

- 0% were transfer students who finished the program in two years.
- Of those who came as freshmen 26.92% they finished in 4 years.
- 60 % completed the degree in five years.
- 41.18% completed the degree in six years.
- (unknown)of the graduating undergraduate students were second bachelor admittees this year.

Retention/Attrition: From 2020-2021 to 2021-2022, the interior design program retention rate was 76% for undergraduate students.
