Eastern Michigan University Interior Design Program Student Achievement Data Fall 2022

Job Placement: For the undergraduate graduates from 2021-22, $\underline{47\%}$ were employed in commercial design, $\underline{47\%}$ residential design, $\underline{5\%}$ in other work, $\underline{0\%}$ headed to graduate school. Annual program survey/data-collection for graduates showed $\underline{94\%}$ employed in their major at the time of graduation (April 2022) with $\underline{0\%}$ of those seeking a different type of position with other/more advanced responsibilities.

Acceptance into a Graduate Program: <u>0%</u> of the 2021-22 graduating seniors applied to a graduate program.

Graduation Rates – time to degree: For year 2021-2022 undergraduate graduating students:

- <u>0%</u> were transfer students who finished the program in <u>two</u> years.
- Of those who came as freshmen <u>26.92%</u> they finished in 4 years.
- <u>60 %</u> completed the degree in five years.
- 41.18% completed the degree in six years.
- (unknown)of the graduating undergraduate students were second bachelor admittees this year.

Retention/Attrition: From 2020-2021 to 2021-2022, the interior design program retention rate was $\frac{76\%}{6}$ for undergraduate students.
