

Asma Siddique's Rendering project of Restaurant Design was selected by the jury of Sherwin-Williams for Design Pros. To the Top 20 Student Design Challenge Finalists – 2019.



"I wanted to create a modern and chic restaurant interior, one with a tailored but relaxed vibe. I played with colors, contrasting textures and graphic patterns, in order to infuse the space with a layered look. The space has abundant ambient light so I felt that it could handle a vibrant color scheme. I took a monochromatic palette of blues, along with white lacquer, wood, antique brass, and then added a couple of shades of mauve in order to achieve an inviting and informal ambiance. Because one side of the restaurant is completely covered in windows, I wanted to create an equal strong accent wall on the opposite end and used a bold Sherwin-Williams color palette to achieve this...I tempered the wall though with a neutral background in order to create visual harmony. The swooping arches of the accent wall bring attention to the high ceilings and gives the space architectural proportion. The bold colors hold up well to the Moroccan tiles and the reflective surface of the ceiling." - Asma Siddique
