Student Achievement Data Fall 2021

Job Placement: For the undergraduate graduates from 2020-21, 20% were employed in commercial design, 34% residential design, 40% in other work, 6% headed to graduate school.

Annual program survey/data-collection for graduates showed 60% employed in their major at the time of graduation (April 2021) with 37% of those seeking a different type of position with other/more advanced responsibilities.

Acceptance into a Graduate Program: One of the 2020-21 graduating seniors applied to a graduate program and was accepted and is enrolled for fall 2021 (architecture master's degree).

Graduation Rates - time to degree: For year 2020-2021 undergraduate graduating students, 15% were transfer students who finished the program in two years. Of those who came as freshmen (63%) they finished in 4 years. Fifteen percent completed the degree in five years and 7% in six years. None of the graduating undergraduate students were second bachelor admittees this year.

Retention/Attrition: From 2019-2020 to 2020-2021, the interior design program retention rate was 90% for undergraduate students.
