

### John Sullivan Scholarship

A scholarship award consisting of tuition and fees for one credit hour of research for the next Fall term will be given to one student attending EMU. Applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Applicants must have completed CHEM 123/124 or 125/126 by the beginning of the award period.
2. Student must obtain permission from at least one faculty member to register for research under his/her direction (See attached form).
3. The application must be submitted to the Chemistry Club officers by February 6, 2015.
4. Preference will be given to applicants who are active in the Chemistry Club.
5. Students who are awarded the scholarship must join the American Chemical Society as a student affiliate (membership fee) and provide proof to the Chemistry Club within six weeks of notification that they have received the award.
6. Sullivan Award winner will make a short presentation of his/her research project at a future meeting of the Chemistry Club.
