**“Your Epigenome: DNA is

Dr. Dana Dolinoy leads the Environmental Epigenetics and Nutrition Laboratory at the University of Michigan School of Public Health and serves as Associate Professor in the Environmental Health Sciences and Nutritional Sciences departments.

The Dolinoy Lab investigates the role played by environmental exposure to chemical, nutritional, and behavioral factors that can alter gene expression and affect health; this has included the potentially harmful effects of many common compounds, such as bisphenol A (BPA).

Her research is conducted using animal models, human clinical samples, and human population studies. Her work has recently been recognized as a model approach that may allow for direct assessment of the impact of environmental exposure on human disease.
