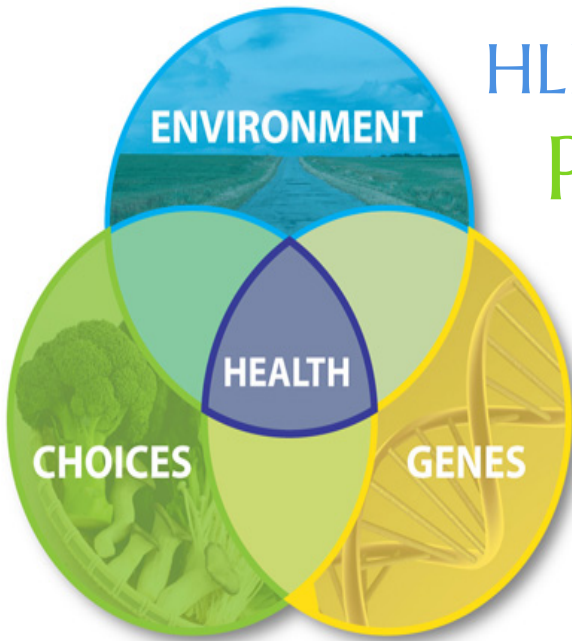

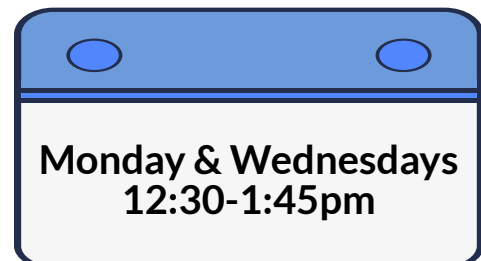


HLED 379 SPECIAL TOPICS PUBLIC HEALTH AND THE ENVIRONMENT
