What Classes are Offered Winter 2019?

The following courses required in the Health Education Minor are offered in winter 2019:
HLED 130, HLED 250, HLED 260, HLED 270, HLED 380 & HLED 490

If you have not already taken HLED 260: *Introduction to Community Health*, we strongly encourage you to take it this winter (2019). HLED 260 is a prerequisite for HLED 380 *Psychosocial Health & Service Learning*, which will be offered next fall.

Are You Following the Old Requirements?

Starting with the 2015/2016 EMU Catalog, the Health Education Minor requirements changed. The information in #1 and #2 above refer to the new Health Education Minor requirements.

The old Health Education Minor requirements included HLED 305 *Current Health Issues I* and HLED 315 *Current Health Issues II*. If you are following a catalog prior to 2015/2016 and are planning to take these courses, it is important to know that they will be offered only once more. HLED 305 will be offered in winter 2019. HLED 315 will be offered in summer 2019. After that, you will need to follow Step 4 (substitutions).

Some Classes are Only Offered One Semester a Year

It is easy to plan your Health Education Minor schedule if you remember that some classes are only offered one semester a year.

Winter Only HLED Courses:

HLED 260: *Introduction to Community Health* (its a prerequisite for HLED 380)

Fall Only HLED Courses

HLED 371 *Injury & Violence Prevention*

HLED 380 *Psychosocial Health & Service Learning*

4 Substitutions for HLED 305 and HLED 315

If you are following the old requirements (you started at EMU prior to 2015) you can substitute new Health Education Minor courses for the old requirement of HLED 305 and HLED 315.

The allowable substitutions include:

HLED 250 *Communicable and Non-Communicable Diseases* for HLED 315 *Current Health Issues II*.

HLED 371 *Injury & Violence Prevention* for HLED 305 *Current Health Issues I*.
