### **Organic or Biochemistry Lecture**

**one of the following:**

- CHEM 132: Principles of Organic and Biological Chemistry (4 hrs) – includes lab
- CHEM 241: Organic Chemistry I (4 hrs) **and** lab (see below)
- CHEM 242: Organic Chemistry II (4 hrs) **and** lab (see below)

### **Organic or Biochemistry Lab**

**one of the following:**

- CHEM 243: Microscale Organic Chemistry Lab I (2 hrs) **and** lecture (see above)
- CHEM 244: Microscale Organic Chemistry Lab II (2 hrs) **and** lecture (see above)

## **Microbiology with Lab**

**one of the following:**

- BIO 135: Microbiology for Allied Health Sciences (4 hrs)
- BIO 251: Microbiology (5 hrs)

## **Lifespan Psychology**

- PSY 253: Life Span Development (3 hrs)

## **Statistics**

- MATH 141: Introduction to Statistics (4 hrs)
