<u>Distinguished Alumni Award</u> - The purpose of this award is to recognize alumni who have made truly exceptional contributions to the profession, the university, the college or the School of Nursing. One award may be given out annually.

Criteria for the Award

- 1. Significant contributions to the nursing profession
- 2. Active involvement as a leader within a nursing organization
- 3. Currently working in the nursing profession
- 4. Notable contributions to nursing research, scholarship or education
- 5. Community involvement
- 6. Graduated from EMU School of Nursing at least 5 years prior to nomination
- 7. Maintained a relationship with EMU School of Nursing since graduation

Submission Instructions

- Nominations may be made by School of Nursing faculty, staff, or nursing students at EMU. Self-nominations will be accepted.
- The application should include the name of the individual, address, and telephone number and a brief essay (not to exceed 750 words) outlining how this candidate meets the award criteria

Application Award Deadline is April 1, 2015.

Selection Process

- The School of Nursing faculty will review the award nomination and vote for the awards annually. Award winner name, contact information and bio will be forwarded immediately following the vote to the CHHS Dean's office for student notification.
- Annual awards may be given, but are not expected.
