This packet is intended to assist you in completing the online application for the BSN or BSN 2nd Degree program. We encourage you to read through this material and contact the CHHS Advising Center at 734.487.0918 with any questions before you begin completing the application.

Thank you for interest in the BSN program at Eastern Michigan University. Please make certain you viewed the virtual School of Nursing Information session and if you have not already done so, meet with a Nursing-Intent academic advisor. You can view the virtual information session at <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=tK5oyyyaoL8>. Completing this application should be relatively easy if you have done those things in advance.

In order to complete the online application, you must first be admitted to Eastern Michigan University and have your Eagle ID number before applying to the School of Nursing. Admission to EMU does not guarantee admission to the nursing program.

It is your responsibility to submit the following documentation to the EMU Office of Admission, P.O. Box 921, Ypsilanti, MI 48197:

- Official transcripts from all college/universities attended
- Official translated transcripts from foreign universities (Educational Perspectives provides this service)
- International Students need to submit TOEFL scores for reading, spelling, listening, and writing

Students who currently hold a Bachelors (or higher) degree must first meet with the Second Degree Advisor in Academic Advising, 301 Pierce Hall (734.487.5497). If you have a Bachelor's Degree in any discipline, application to both programs is permitted.

There is a \$30 application fee.

In order to complete this section of the application, you will be asked to enter in data from your transcripts. You may want to complete this on this form and simply re-enter it on the application. You will need the following information:

1. Enter in the college/university where you took the course, as well as the semester.
2. Enter in the credit hours for each course.
3. Enter the grade in each course (using the grading scale conversion table below, if necessary).
4. Enter in the number of credits (per course) that you took at EMU. If you took them elsewhere, enter 0.
5. Enter in your actual ATI TEAS scores for each component (Reading, Math, Science & Writing).
6. Indicate "Yes" or "No" whether you have 6 months or greater health care work experience.
7. Indicate whether you have a course waiver (Math, English, AP or CLEP).
8. Indicate whether you have taken NURS 110 and completed with a "C" or better grade.

Important Notes:

- A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better in the pre-requisite courses is required.
- Chemistry, anatomy, or physiology courses older than 10 years are not accepted.
- *If chemistry, anatomy or physiology courses have been taken more than once, you must submit the grades from the **first two attempts**.*
- The University may give credit for nursing courses taken at another college or university; however, the School reserves the right to make the final decision on course substitution based on examination of course materials. Requirements may vary based on prior education. Students must speak with an advisor in the CHHS Intent Advising Office (734.487.0918) for details on transfer equivalencies.

EMU School of Nursing will validate and re-calculate all of the above GPA and point calculations. The calculations of the School of Nursing are the final calculations that will be used for admission considerations. If an error is found, you will be contacted via myemich email or phone to notify you of the error and its correction. You do not need to call if you find an error after submission of the application, we will contact you.
