- CHM 346: Organic Chemistry II (3 hrs) and CHM 349 Organic Chemistry Lab (2 hrs)
- CHM 421: Survey of Biochemistry (3 hrs) and CHM 349 Organic Chemistry Lab (2 hrs)

Microbiology with Lab

one of the following:

- □ BIO 208: Microbiology (3 hrs)

Lifespan Psychology
