Human Anatomy & Human Physiology

- BIOL 2710: Human Physiological Anatomy (6 hrs)

General Chemistry with Lab

one of the following:

- CHEM 1050: Introduction to General Chemistry (4 hrs) – includes lab
- CHEM 1170: General Chemistry I (4 hrs) – includes lab
- CHEM 1180: General Chemistry II (4 hrs) – includes lab

Organic or Biochemistry with Lab

one of the following:

- CHEM 1060: Introduction to Organic Chemistry & Biochemistry (4 hrs) – includes lab
- CHEM 2260: Organic Chemistry I (4 hrs) **and** CHEM 2270: Organic Chemistry Laboratory (2 hrs)

Microbiology with Lab

one of the following:

- BIOL 2400: General Microbiology (4 hrs) – includes lab
- BIOL 2730: Pathogenic Microbiology (4 hrs) – includes lab

Lifespan Psychology

- PSYC 2450: Lifespan Development (3 hrs)

Statistics

- MATH 1340: Statistics (4 hrs)
- PSYC 2170: Psychological Statistics (4 hrs)
