Authorization to Administer NonPrescription Medication  
Licensing Rule R400.8260

If you are giving or applying any nonprescription medication to a child in care, the following must be completed by the parent/guardian for each nonprescription medication. An interruption in nonprescription medication will require a new permission form.

**NONPRESCRIPTION MEDICATION INCLUDING:** Diapering Cream, Triple Antibiotic Cream, Treatments for Allergies, Cough Syrup. Per Licensing it does not include Hand Sanitizer, Hand or Body Lotion. It does not include Vaseline or other petroleum jelly-based products or Lip Balm.

**NONPRESCRIPTION MEDICATION:** Nonprescription medications must be labeled with the child's name and be in the original package. Containers like baggies, old prescription bottles, or others are not allowed. Staff shall give or apply nonprescription medication according to the directions on the original container, unless otherwise authorized by a written Doctors note from the child's licensed health care provider. If the label on a nonprescription medication says that a physician should be consulted for the dosage, including if it says to consult a Dr. for a specific age or weight, you must get written instructions from the physician before we will give the child the medication.

**ALL MEDICATION:** A separate Authorization Form is needed for each nonprescription medication that your child is to receive. Because of the possibility of an unknown allergy, the Children's Institute staff will give **no** first dose of **any** medication.

**STORAGE OF NONPRESCRIPTION MEDICATION:** All nonprescription medication will be stored out of the reach of children.
