The EIF is a student-managed investment fund under faculty supervision that gives students the unique opportunity to apply classroom finance concepts to real world investing. Involvement in the fund will provide students with an excellent opportunity for professional development and the chance to work with Eastern Michigan's top finance students. EIF members also get the opportunity to interact with the Professional Advisory Board, which is comprised of leading investment professionals. Once admitted, students have the commitment of one academic year to manage the fund. Fund managers have the obligation to attend meetings, finish assigned work, and present reports. Selected students will act as analysts and work on sector teams to analyze equity securities and develop comprehensive reports for trading decisions under the supervision and mentorship of the faculty advisors. First time analysts will also learn value investing and financial modeling in a series of hands-on training sessions led by the fund's Faculty Advisors.
