RE-ACCREDITATION

The Speech Language Pathology (SLP) program, Department of Special Education, at Eastern Michigan University is seeking re-accreditation of its graduate program from the Council of Academic Accreditation (CAA) associated with the American Speech-Language and Hearing Association. As a part of the process, the public is invited to present comments with respect to the program at an open public meeting scheduled for Monday, March 6, 2017 at 1:15pm - 2:15pm in COE Clinical Suite - Porter 135 F1, Eastern Michigan University.

Individual who wish to provide input about a CAA-accredited program seeking reaccreditation may do so in two ways:

- a. Submit written comments to Accreditation Public Comment Council on Academic Accreditation in Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology (CAA), American Speech-Language-Hearing Association, 2200 Research Blvd #310, Rockville, MD 20850 (or accreditation@asha.org) no later than February 18, 2017. Include your name, address and telephone contact information and your relationship to the program in order for Accreditation staff to verify the source of the testimony. The comments must be signed.
- b. Provide comments at a public meeting to be held Monday, March 6, 1:15pm - 2:15 pm at COE Clinical Suites-Porter 135, Eastern Michigan University, Ypsilanti, MI.

All comments provided must:

- Relate to a program's compliance with the current published Standards for Accreditation of Graduate Education Programs in Audiology and Speech Language Pathology (Standards), and
- Identify the specific program seeking candidacy, initial accreditation, or reaccreditation with the CAA
