Benchmark 1. Increase the dissemination of faculty scholarship.

Objective

4. Increase faculty-student scholarship dissemination.

Strategies**a. FY20-FY24**

- i. Increase the numbers of students and faculty together publishing papers together based on shared research efforts and on the dissemination of the students' thesis and dissertations.
- ii. Examine program curriculum to create assignments that have potential to be converted to disseminated scholarship.

b. FY21

- i. Increase the numbers of students receiving travel support for presenting papers / scholarly presentations which are linked to publication.

c. FY21-FY23

- i. Create COE awards for outstanding scholarship by students. Develop COE award for Graduate Research Conference and further award for the conversion of this scholarship for external dissemination.
- ii. Develop post- dissemination reward model to incentivize faculty-student scholarly activity.
- iii. Update departmental DED to reflect this objective.

Measurable Outcomes

- a. Have revision of L&C TED DEDs updated.
- b. Annual change in thesis and dissertations published or disseminated from a baseline publication rate as reported in FY 19.
- c. Gather baseline data on co-presentations of students with faculty from FY19
 - i. The annual number of doctoral students making at least one presentation annually.
 - ii. The annual number of local, state, regional, and national / international presentations.
 - iii. The annual number of presentations that were reworked and submitted for publication.

- d. Dollars available to students for presenting at conferences looking to see if it increases annually.
- e. Document the current numbers and types of presentations and the total dollar support for any source.

\$ needed

- a. \$15,000 for additional student travel support to present papers
