**Goal 3.** Encourage and strengthen the scholarly work and its dissemination done in the college  
**Benchmark 1.** Increase the dissemination of faculty scholarship.

**Objective**

6. Increase the number of faculty engaged in externally funded research and the dollar amount of external funding received.

**Strategies**a. **FY20-FY24**

- i. Provide summer support for faculty writing external grants
  1. Must be fully submitted by the end of the summer (mid-fall of the same year at the latest).
  2. Priority given to faculty who wish to seek external funds for an internal grant they have or have recently had
  3. Priority given to faculty seeking \$500,000 or more in their grant proposal
- ii. Support 1-2 faculty annually in the ORDA CoRE program
  1. One COE 3-hour course release in winter of first CoRE year
  2. One COE 3-hour course release the next fall
  3. An expected submission of at least one major (\$500,000) grant and/or several (\$50,000 to \$499,999) grants
- iii. Department heads scan announcements from ORDA, the Foundation grants office, and other sources for RFP/grant initiatives that are aligned with departmental programs/projects
  1. Inform specific faculty of appropriate external funding opportunities aligned with their scholarly and professional interests
  2. Inform all departmental faculty of appropriate external funding opportunities regardless of whether it is aligned with their scholarly and professional interests or not.
  3. Encourage faculty to apply for these external funding opportunities and others the faculty discover through other sources
  4. Facilitate the support of ORDA and if appropriate the Foundation grants office for the faculty or team who is interested in the grant opportunity
  5. Work with ORDA, and if appropriate the Foundation grants office, to engage faculty a year if possible ahead of the actual call of likely

RFPs/grant initiatives so seeking partners and planning for the submission and begin early.

6. Support current and create new school, university, and community partnerships that in part are linked to external funding opportunities.

**b. FY21-FY24**

- i. Support faculty travel and other costs for additional research training or to visit grant officers on particular funding opportunities.

**Measurable Outcomes**

**1. Summer support and CoRE:**

- a. Names of faculty, and if applicable students, supported in writing grant proposals
- b. Whether or not the grant or project was funded,
- c. Dollars amount of summer or CoRE support provided to each project by the College

**2. All College supported grants or projects**

- a. Copy of full submitted proposal including
  - i. budget
  - ii. abstract
  - iii. proposal
  - iv. evaluation plan
  - v. requested size of grant
  - vi. any cost share
  - vii. requested distribution of IDCs
  - viii. date submitted
- b. later: if it was funded or not and amount funded and any changes to the approved plan from the one submitted.

**3. Support faculty travel and other costs for additional research training or to visit grant officers on particular funding opportunities**

- a. Dollars of support provided on each project
- b. Names of faculty and others who received the support.
- c. Description of training or visit supported

**4. COE annual report on external grant and projects**

- a. Number and list of faculty submitting external grants and/or projects
- b. Number and list of those grants and/or projects that were funded in that reporting year
- c. The individual and total dollars expended annually from all COE or COE participating externally funded grants or projects

**\$ needed**

- a. **Summer support:**
  - i. **FY21-FY24:** \$10,000 @ \$5000 each
- b. **CoRE:**
  - i. **Winter and Fall 2020:** course releases for two faculty 4 total @ \$3,800 = \$15,200
  - b. **Winter and Fall 2021:** course releases for two faculty 4 total @ \$3,800 = \$15,200
  - c. **Winter and Fall 2022:** course releases for two faculty 4 total @ \$3,800 = \$15,200
  - d. **Winter and Fall 2023:** course releases for two faculty 4 total @ \$3,800 = \$15,200
  - e. **Winter and Fall 2024:** course releases for two faculty 4 total @ \$3,800 = \$15,200
- f. **Faculty grant participation, training, and travel:**
  - i. **FY21-FY24:** Up to \$5,000 total across the COE in each fiscal year
