Outstanding Graduate Awards*

This award is given to graduate students with high academic achievement.

For Undergraduate Students:

Dr. Mildred Lintner Student Scholarship Award*: This award is based on student performance in a 100-level COSC course.

The Charlie Jones Memorial Scholarship: This is a monetary award sponsored by Prof. Bahorski.

- Applicants are asked to articulate: *How have you demonstrated experience with, or commitment to, serving or working with historically under-represented or underprivileged populations?*
- Declared major in Computer Science (curriculum, applied major, or secondary education in computer science)
- Completed at least two 200-level or above courses in computer science at Eastern Michigan University.
- Must show continued commitment to taking computer science courses towards his or her major while maintaining at least 9 credit hours or more per semester at Eastern Michigan University for the past two major semesters.
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Minimum computer science GPA of 3.0

Outstanding Senior Award*: This award is given to an upper-level non-graduating senior (100 or more credits) student with high academic achievement.

Finlin Award*: This award is given to a senior-year student solely on academic merit, without regard to financial need. The student must:

- Have a minimum GPA of 3.5;
- Be a non-teaching Computer Science major;
- Have demonstrated academic achievement in the field of Computer Science; and
- Maintain at least 9 credits per semester.

* Note: Monetary awards typically range between \$250 - \$400. The department head determines the amount of the award on a yearly basis.

Department Service Award: This award is a monetary scholarship award given to a student for service rendered for the Computer Science department or to the field of computer science. The department head determines the amount of the award on a yearly basis.
