Doctoral Faculty Awards

Purpose and Nature of the Award

Cash awards on a reimbursement basis for financial support that is intended to encourage and support the research, teaching, and scholarly endeavors of COT faculty working with COT doctoral students. Awards will be made for up to \$500 per request for needs consistent with the guidelines.

Timeline

Proposals may be submitted at any time. No fewer than ten awards will be available during any funding cycle.

Proposal Procedure

Complete and submit the attached application form along with supporting documentation listing costs for travel, reference, software or materials that are being requested.

Evaluation Criteria

The primary criterion is that the requested funding will support the enhancement of doctoral classes or the mentoring of doctoral students. Requests for activities that have already occurred will not be funded.

Allowable Items

Although a wide range of proposals is sought, the following items and activities (in no particular order) are allowable and consistent with the goals of the award program:

1. Funding for travel with doctoral students to make joint scholarly presentations
2. Resources to help support joint research with doctoral students
3. Specialized software, reference, or other materials not conveniently available for use in doctoral classes
