- Or, if no Occupational Certificate (IOC) 4,000 hours of paid recent (last 6 years) and relevant work experience in Healthcare and current appropriate licensure.
- Prefer valid Michigan Professional/Provisional Teacher Certification in a related science.
- Must possess organizational and technology skills, be detail oriented, have a strong teamwork ethic and excellent communication skills
- Communication, organizational and networking skills required.
- Prefer experience working with high school age students and diverse student population.
- American Heart Association Basic Life Support Instructor desirable.
- Train the Trainer or experience in long - term care.

Job Responsibilities:

- Instruct students by lecturing, demonstrating, and using audiovisual aids and other materials to supplement presentations.
- Develop project based learning experiences and effectively integrate lab equipment into student learning and assessment.
- Assign lessons and correct homework.
- Administer tests to evaluate pupil progress, record results, and issue reports to inform parents of progress.
- Keep attendance records.
