Description:

One-third of Americans rely on groundwater for drinking and it is important to ensure this water source is free of contaminants. In this course we will apply principles of chemistry, biology, and geology to explore issues of contaminated groundwater. Students will then conduct a research project requiring community involvement, groundwater sampling, and basic chemical analyses to determine human health risk.
