- (4) Must submit a paper on a subject closely related to the discipline of economics.

Endowed Scholarship**

Originally created in 1977 by alumni Bruce C. Gockerman and Gary E. Murg, this award was known as the Gockerman-Murg Award. In 1983 the award was split into two separate endowed scholarship funds with different application requirements.

- (1) Must be an EMU student.
- (2) Must have junior or senior status.
- (3) Must be an economics major.
- (4) Must have outstanding record of service to the Economics Department.
- (5) Nominations made by students or faculty members.

**Donald W. Pearson  
Endowed Scholarship**

Originally established by Professor Emeritus Donald Pearson in 2012 as an expendable scholarship, this award officially became endowed in 2013.

- (1) Must be an EMU student.
- (2) Must be an economics major or minor.
- (3) Must have a minimum G.P.A. of 3.0 (overall and in economic courses).
- (4) Preference given to Honors Program participants and/or students with international study experience.
- (5) The student would be eligible for a second year renewal of the scholarship.

**STEM in Economics  
Scholarship**

Originally established in 2021, this scholarship intends to promote the new STEM degrees in Economics.

- (1) Must be an EMU student.
- (2) Must be an economics major or graduate student with a STEM degree in Economics.
