

Enhancements to Campus Cleaning Protocols Due to COVID-19

The University continues to take precautions to ensure the health and well-being of the campus community in light of the Coronavirus (COVID-19).

University Custodial Services has increased its cleaning and disinfecting processes in several areas. These include:

- Disinfecting touch points (door handles, light switches, etc.) in common spaces around campus, including residence halls. This process will continue throughout the semester.
- Initiated regular power washing of restrooms in common event areas (REC/IM, Bowen/Warner, Student Center, Quirk, Alexander) and the use of electrostatic disinfectant spray to fog the areas. This process will continue in all restrooms around the campus.
- Increased frequency of power washing in the Wise Hall community bathrooms to twice per day.
- Additional personnel resources have been committed to this process.
- Processes currently being used are: disinfecting wipes (Clorox), disinfectant cleaners (3M and SC Johnson), disinfecting spray (Clorox 360 and Phenofog). All disinfectants used follow CDC recommendations.
- The University is working with vendors and contractors to maintain the products and services to continue this cleaning schedule moving forward.

These services are in addition to the routine cleaning schedule, which includes:

- Common bathrooms in residence halls are cleaned five days a week, with the exception of Wise Hall which is cleaned seven days a week. Entrance doors to those bathrooms are cleaned five days per week.
- Dining areas and the restrooms in The Commons and Eateries dining facilities are cleaned seven days a week, and at the MarketPlace five days a week. The dining areas are cleaned every day they are open.
- In classroom buildings, bathroom fixtures and floors are cleaned five times a week.
- Classrooms are cleaned three to five times a week.
- The REC/IM locker rooms are power washed and electrostatic fogged five days a week.

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
