

Receive a free COVID-19 vaccine on campus!

To all students & employees:

Please read this email carefully and in its entirety to register to receive a COVID-19 vaccine on campus this week.

In partnership with the Washtenaw County Health Department (WHCD), Eastern Michigan University is pleased to provide students and employees with the opportunity to receive a free COVID-19 vaccine on campus this week. The vaccine being administered is the one-dose Johnson & Johnson, which means that you will NOT need to return for a second shot. As outlined below, you must pre-register to receive a vaccine. **Please do not forward this invitation to other individuals and, unfortunately, family members are not eligible.**

Date, Time and Location:

Vaccines will be available at the following times and locations. **You must pre-register to receive a vaccine (see below). No walk-ins are allowed.**

** You must complete the University's [COVID PASS Daily Health Screening](#) before you enter McKenny Hall, and you may be asked to show your COVID PASS clearance on your cell phone at the building check-in desk. You are not required to complete a COVID PASS Daily Health Screening if you receive your vaccine at the Convocation Center on Tuesday, April 13.*

How do I register for the vaccine?

We urge you to schedule your vaccine appointment as soon as possible because vaccine supply is limited and we expect that demand for this on-campus vaccination opportunity will be high. Once the current appointment slots are filled, no new slots will be added.

You must use your EMICH EMAIL ADDRESS when you register so we can identify you as affiliated with Eastern Michigan University.

Parking:

Convocation Center: Free parking is available at the Convocation Center for Tuesday's vaccination clinic.

McKenny: Free parking is available in both the McKenny guest lot and Briggs guest lot for the vaccination clinics that will be held in the McKenny Ballroom on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday. [Here is a map of EMU parking lots.](#)

Other information:

- The Johnson & Johnson/Janssen vaccine is recommended for people 18 years and older.
- The vaccine is given by a single injection (shot) in the muscle of the upper arm.
- If you have an allergy to polysorbate, you should not receive this vaccine.
- This vaccination opportunity is for EMU students, faculty, and staff only. Unfortunately, we are not able to provide the vaccine for family members.
- After vaccination and for the following 1 - 2 days, you may experience mild side effects such as fever, muscle aches, headache, joint aches or chills. If you are still experiencing any of the mild side effects after that time period, please contact your primary care physician or EMU Telehealth at (734) 487-3865.
- It is recommended that you schedule your appointment to be vaccinated for a time when you have a day or two off to recuperate should symptoms or signs of reaction occur.

Thank you for your cooperation as we work with the Washtenaw County Health Department to administer the vaccine to Eastern's community.
