

## **On-campus COVID-19 tests during the summer**

To students, faculty and staff,

The University's COVID-19 Testing Center will continue to offer free COVID-19 tests to members of the campus community throughout the summer. Testing is an important factor in EMU's successful efforts to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 among our campus community -- we encourage you to be tested regularly!

### **Who can receive a free COVID-19 test?**

Any member of the EMU community may receive a free COVID-19 test at the University's Testing Center. We encourage students living on campus and in the surrounding neighborhoods, staff who are working on campus, and instructors who teach in-person to take advantage of this opportunity on a regular basis, not just when required.

**During Summer A and Summer B semesters, residents living on campus will be required to continue testing twice per month** through the Testing Center. A specific message will be sent to summer on-campus housing residents outlining more details.

We encourage continued routine COVID-19 testing even if you are fully vaccinated. While being vaccinated limits the symptoms of COVID-19 should you contract it, vaccinated individuals may still be a carrier of COVID-19 and inadvertently spread it to friends and family. The COVID-19 vaccine will not cause a positive test result because the vaccine does not contain the live virus.

### **How do you register to receive a free COVID-19 test?**

Any member of the campus community may sign up for **free** COVID-19 testing through [emich.edu/covid-testing](https://emich.edu/covid-testing). You must register for a test before you arrive for an appointment.

### **When & where can you receive a free COVID-19 test?**

EMU's on-campus Testing Center is located in the lower level of the Student Center (next to the Bookstore). Visit the [testing website](#) to review the Center's schedule because hours are subject to change.

Please note that the Testing Center will be closed between April 28 and May 4 due to water maintenance at the Student Center. The Testing Center will be open in the subsequent weeks as follows:

**Thursday, May 6 - 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.**  
**Tuesday, May 11 - 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.**

**Wednesday, May 19 - 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.**
